August 1 – October 15 History Revealed marker applications accepted

October 30 - November 15 Marker committee selects five recipients

December 1 Applicants are notified of results; Committee begins consultation on marker texts

April 7-9, 2022 History Revealed markers are announced at Association's annual meeting
